



WHICH VOCAL CLASS SHOULD I ENTER?

In all classes:-

The adjudicator will be looking for:

Accuracy - of pitch and rhythm.

Communication - your involvement in your performance.

Interpretation - are you following the composer's intentions in terms of tempo and performance directions?

In a group - are you balanced, in time, in tune and working with each other?

REMEMBER

- Smile and be confident.
- Take a bow at the end.
- IT IS OKAY TO STOP AND START AGAIN IF YOU NEED TO.
- You may introduce your piece with the title and composer or ask for it to be announced for you. (you will not be marked down for this).

Class 1 Primary Singing Solo (excluding pop))	Perform one single piece of music. You should dress as you would for a concert performance (dress to impress). <u>You are not required to wear costume or include any actions and props</u>	Traditional songs Folk songs Classical songs Songs from Musical theatre and film
Class 2 Primary Singing Solo Musical Theatre	Perform one single piece of music. You <u>must</u> learn your words and perform your piece from memory. You <u>must</u> wear costume relating to the piece to be performed. Your performance <u>must</u> include actions/acting as appropriate. You may use up to two props in your performance.	Songs from musical theatre and film Traditional music hall songs
Class 3 Primary Singing Duets & Trios	Perform one single piece of music. You should dress as you would for a concert performance (dress to impress). You may introduce your piece with the title and composer, or ask for it to be announced for you. (you will not be marked down for this). Make sure to make eye contact with each other during your performance.	Traditional songs Folk songs Classical songs Songs from Musical theatre and film

Class 4 Primary Singing Duets & Trios Musical Theatre	Perform one single piece of music. You <u>must</u> learn your words and perform your piece from memory. You <u>must</u> wear costume relating to the piece to be performed Your performance <u>must</u> include actions/acting as appropriate. You may use up to two props in your performance	Songs from musical theatre and film Traditional music hall songs.
Class 5 Primary Choir 4 - 20 performers	You <u>must</u> perform two contrasting pieces. A member, or members of your group should introduce each piece with the title and composer. You <u>must</u> learn your words and perform your piece from memory. You may use props to enhance your performance if appropriate.	Traditional songs Folk songs Classical songs Songs from musical theatre and film – age appropriate please.
Class 14 a & b Senior Singing Solo	Perform one single piece of music. You should dress as you would for a concert performance (dress to impress). <u>You are not required to wear costume or include any actions and props</u>	Traditional songs Folk songs Classical songs Songs from Musical theatre and film
Class 15 a & b Senior Singing Solo Musical Theatre	Perform one single piece of music. You <u>must</u> learn your words and perform your piece from memory. You <u>must</u> wear costume relating to the piece to be performed. Your performance <u>must</u> include actions/acting as appropriate. You may use up to two props in your performance. Class 16 a & b Senior Singing Duets & Trios	Perform one single piece of music. You should dress as you would for a concert performance (dress to impress).	Traditional songs Folk songs
