Please make your payment online **via BACS (details on entry forms) – PLEASE DON'T SEND CASH OR CHEQUES**

The number of entries will dictate if the Festival will be spread over 4 days. We will endeavour to hold all the senior sections on the Sundays BUT please make sure you are available on all 4 days. The first section of the day will start at 9am and the last section will be complete no later than 6pm (unless the number of entries makes this impossible).

Rules and conditions

1. **No photography/video recording** will be allowed at the Festival (except by Wenlock Olympian Society/Live Arts). This is a requirement of the British and International Federation of Festivals.
Images captured at the festival may be used for media and/or publicity purposes (unless there are safeguarding issues the organisers have been made aware of).
2. Competitors must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
3. A time limit is indicated for each class. Performances exceeding this time may be stopped.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse the use of any electrical equipment.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to combine or reorganise classes depending on the number of entries received or remove due to lack of entries. Dancers may dance up an age if no one else has entered their section.
6. Entry Fees (must be accompanied by a completed entry form):

7. Age Groups:
Primary – Competitors up to and including year 3 – up to age 8
Junior – Competitors from year 4 to year 6 – up to age 11
Intermediate – Competitors from year 7 to year 9 – up to age 14
Seniors – Competitors from year 10 to year 13 or age 18
'Year' means school year not age BUT age must be as of 31st August 2026.
8. Competitors must be aged 18 or under on 31st August 2026.
9. Notification: Competitors will be notified of the date and time of their class by 24th February. Please ensure you are available to compete on the relevant day before submitting your entry form.
10. Please contact the organiser if you have not received your notification information by 1st March.
11. Each competitor (excluding groups) will be awarded a participation certificate if they are not placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd. Groups will be awarded a group participation certificate per group NOT per dancer.
12. Gold, silver and bronze Wenlock Olympian medals along with first, second and third place certificates will be awarded in each class to solos, duets and trios with each dancer receiving a medal and certificate. In the Group sections one Gold, Silver and Bronze medal will be awarded with the corresponding certificate, all other dancers in the winning groups will receive a medal (to be collected by the teacher at the end of the

festival). In all classes - in the event that 3 golds are awarded, silver and bronze will not be awarded, if 2 silvers are awarded bronze will not be awarded but multiple bronzes may be awarded following 1 gold and 1 silver.

13. Props: It is a condition of entry that parents/teachers and/or carers must take responsibility for the supply and safe operation of the props at all times. The Organiser has the right to refuse any prop which it deems inappropriate or could potentially cause harm if not used correctly.
14. The **DANCER OF THE YEAR** (dancer selected from the Primary & Junior sections) and the **DANCER OF THE YEAR** (dancer selected from the Intermediate & Senior sections) will each be awarded a trophy and certificate.
15. The decision of the adjudicator shall be final and binding.

Dance Section Rules

1. All performers must be warmed up and ready at least 20 minutes prior to the competition.
2. Make-up, hair and costume may be worn in any style appropriate to the dance but NO jewellery is to be worn, for reasons related to Health and Safety. **Any performer wearing an inappropriate costume may be disqualified.**
3. All music tracks must be submitted as MP3s and labelled clearly prior to the festival (email instruction from Dance Lead). Appropriate lyrics will be permitted in the accompaniment (please note NO lyrics in Song & Dance) – please discuss with the section organiser if you are unsure.
4. In the event of inappropriate language within the music choice the performance will be stopped immediately.
5. Dancers will be limited to an entry of no more than **two** dances in each class in the duet & trio/quartet sections with a change of partner(s) or genre. Group entries are limited to **two** groups per school in each class. If the numbers of entries in the Classical and Cabaret sections are high then the sections may be split down further and you may be advised that further entries will be accepted.
6. The studio door will remain closed while competitors are performing and while the adjudicator is presenting awards.
7. We reserve the right to combine or reorganise classes depending on the number of entries received.
